TVCA UPPER SCHOOL DANCE ATTIRE GUIDELINES

LADIES - WHAT TO WEAR

Formal Dance: A formal dress. May be strapless.

Semi Formal Dance: Dress, skirt and blouse, or dress slacks and blouse. Strapless dresses or tops are not allowed.

Casual Dance: The Non-Uniform Dress Code for School-Sponsored Events as found in the Family Handbook will be followed.

GENTLEMEN - WHAT TO WEAR

Formal Dance: Tuxedo or dark suit. Collared, buttoned up, tucked-in shirt. Tie. Belt, suspenders, or cummerbund. No casual hats.

Semi Formal Dance: Collared, button up, tucked-in shirt. Dress pants. Tie & belt or suspenders. No jeans. No casual hats.

Casual Dance: The Non-Uniform Dress Code for School-Sponsored Events as found in the Family Handbook will be followed.

ATTIRE GUIDELINES:

- 1. Length of dresses or skirts:
 - a. Semi-Formal/Casual: Hemline must be long enough to cover the upper 3/4 of the thigh when standing. Slits, or shortest hemline on high or low dresses, may not extend past this line either.
 - b. Formal: Same length rules for semi-formal/casual but floor length dresses recommended.
- 2. Dress features: The body of the dress from length minimum above to neckline must have solid, opaque, non-sheer material and must not have cutouts.
- 3. Neckline: Front neckline may not extend lower than the line formed between the right and left armpit when arms are relaxed at sides.
- 4. Back: Back of dress/blouse may not extend lower than 3" below the base of the shoulder blades.
- 5. Pants: Must be worn at the waist.
- 6. Shirts/Blouses/Tops: Must cover abdomen at all times. Must conform to neckline and back requirements.
- 7. Clothing should not be excessively tight or form fitting.
- 8. Undergarments must be worn.
- 9. Undergarments must not be visible.
- 10. Clothing must be clean and pressed.
- 11. Shoes must be worn and be neat, in good condition, and complement the attire.
